- At the end of his second term, oldest president to that point: 70

- West Point: 61st in class of 164
- Served under MacArthur (Bonus Army)
- Commander of D-Day invasion
- 1948: President of Columbia University
- 1951: Supreme Commander of NATO



Political Career

- Elected President in 1952; re-elected in 1956
- Defeated Adlai Stevenson in both elections
